Approval Of Agenda: Approved as presented.

**Approval Of Minutes:** The council minutes from 5/8/2025 were approved as presented.

Treasurer's Report: The treasurer's report had an ending balance of \$319,231.90.

The motion to accept the treasury report was moved, seconded, and carried. (5/0)

Old Business: Nothing to discuss.

**New Business:** 

- <u>Jill Koelling Community Center Grant-</u> The Community Center needs a new floor and is seeking a grant to cover the costs. Jill is helping write the grant and would like to know if they can apply through the city. The council approved.
- <u>Terry Hays- Condemning of houses-</u> Mr. Hayes requests time to clean up the two properties he owns that are on the city's condemn list: 801 6<sup>th</sup> Street and 701 N. 3<sup>rd</sup>. He requests about 3 months to work on the properties. The council agreed to give him time to work on these properties but asks that he return in 3 months to evaluate progress.
- Approval of MIH Distribution #6 in the amount of \$102,770.00 -

It was moved and seconded to approve the MIH Disbursement #6 in the amount of \$102,770.00. Motion carried. (5/0)

• Adoption of Resolution 2025-1

It was moved and seconded to adopt Resolution 2025-1 for Region F Hazard Mitigation Plan. Motion carried. (5/0)

• Adoption of Resolution 2025-2

It was moved and seconded to adopt Resolution 2025-2 for the dangerous structure located at 514 N 4th Street. Motion carried. (5/0)

• <u>City dumpster cost change-</u> The cost to dump the city provided roll off dumpster has increased from \$250 to \$400 per dump.

It was moved and seconded to dump the roll off dumpster <u>once every two months</u>. Motion rejected. (2/3)

It was moved and seconded to dump the roll off dumpster once every month. Motion carried. (3/2)

• Lion's Club calendar sponsor- The Clerk stated that she was contacted to see if the city would like to be a sponsor of the Lion's Club calendar. The cost is \$25.00.

It was moved and seconded to purchase sponsorship of the Lion's Club Calendar for \$25.00. Motion carried. (5/0)

• <u>Library roof leak-</u> The clerk informed the council that the library roof was leaking. The council advised the clerk to contact Tom's Flat Roof Repair.

## **City's Superintendent Report:**
