REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

7:02 PM: Mayor called the meeting to order.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: The 2024 Budget was added to the agenda. The agenda was approved as amended.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Minutes from June 8, 2023, were approved as presented.

TREASURER'S REPORT: The Treasurer's Report had an ending balance of \$367,218.00

Kyle moved with a second from Jill to approve the Treasure's Report as presented. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS: No old business to discuss.

NEW BUSINESS: Residents, Mason Bos and Nicholas Racette, presented the desire to place a personally owned vending machine on city property. Kyle moved with a second from Jill to approve the Notice and signature of the Intent to exceed the revenue neutral rate. Motion carried.

The City's storm siren is currently not working for the daily alarms. Adam has contacted Don's Electric and they will be here to look at it when they can.

CITY SUPERINTENDANT'S REPORT: Adam expressed the need for a new lawn mower in the near future.
